Jump starter/Tools/Umbrella/Trolleys

Pool/Gym—Etiquette Post Covid-Restriction.

Dogs on common property

Always ensure your dog is on a lead when on common property, including the foyer, hallways and car park.

The loading dock receives three main deliveries and ad hoc deliveries each day. Some items are large, or multiple boxes.

arrange to pick up your delivered item/s the day you have been notified by us of their arrival.

Community

Secure barcode and wire

Please do not tamper with the secure wire or barcode of your keys. If you wish to make any changes to the key set please advise concierge before dropping them off at the desk. A replacement fee of \$25.00 will be issued if the barcode or wire is tampered with or removed. Our Concierge team need these for holding your keys.

Balcony Etiquette

Consider your neighbors when utilizing your balcony.

PLEASE DO NOT:

- Flick cigarettes over your balcony—use an enclosed ashtray and empty frequently.
- Hose your balcony or push excess water over the edge. Please be careful when watering plants and ensure water falls to the drainage point.
- Make loud noise on your balcony. Bedrooms next door may be close. Keep noise to a minimum.

Illegally Parked Cars & Towing

Please park within your own allocated car space/s.

Contact Concierge if someone is parked in your car parking space. They will attempt to contact the vehicle owner to remove the vehicle and explain the towing process.

It is important you advise Concierge of the vehicle registration number and details of any new vehicle you are bringing into the building for this very reason. If your vehicle is towed, it is an expensive exercise to have it released and it will be at your cost.

Hard Rubbish Collection

Eureka Tower has very limited space to store large waste items for long periods of time, however the loading dock team has arranged two regular pickups each month. Contact the loading dock on 9685 0116 to book the goods lift to bring down your items for hard waste.

Intercom faults

The apartment intercom warranties are coming to an end. If you are experiencing issues with your intercom, please let Concierge know so we can arrange attendance. (service fee may apply). Once the warranty expires, the full cost of repairs is an apartment cost.

Pool Pod

The pool pod (Disabled Lift) is ready for use. An appointment and induction is required for you to use it.
