Following recent Vic. Gov easing of restrictions, our resident facilities have re-opened for double vaccinated residents (those with genuine exemptions) and those who have completed their gym and pool inductions.

Contact concierge to provide proof of vaccination/ exemption or to book your induction if required.

It is important access to residents wanting to come into the gym does not occur. Please continue to wipe down equipment after each use. Limits still apply.

The gym hours are from 4:30am to 11pm daily with regular cleaning in place but without the need to close.

# **Bin Chute Repairs**

We ask you to take note of the recent email to all residents (levels 11-78) advising of repairs re-

quired on the rubbish chute from Monday the 22nd November to Friday the 27th November. During this time the rubbish chute on each floor will be locked off and unavailable.

Building management has organised smaller bins to be placed on each level located in the recycle rooms of levels 11-52 and within the chute rooms of levels 54-79.

The bins will be swapped when full.

Residents have the option to take their rubbish to the basement to assist with this situation if they wish.

#### Packages

The loading dock has seen a vast increase in parcel deliveries this year and as Christmas approaches this will increase further.

All parcels need to be processed. Until you receive notification your package is ready from the loading dock, it is not ready to be picked up.

#### **Parcel Lockers**

Parcel lockers are being installed in the mail room (and Cook Street mail areas). This will make the process of package pick-up guicker and will allow our concierge team to provide you with a greater service.

We will advise all residents when service this is available.


#### New Night Concierge

### Securing bicycles in car park

Bicycle theft is very high in the Southbank Area. Please secure your bicycle properly. We encourage you to look out for tailgaters into the car park and advise concierge immediately of the time this occurs. Use a strong D-Lock on your bike or secure it in the secure cage area in the basement for \$150 per rack per year.

**Note:** Thefts from the car park of private property are not covered under the Owners Corporation insurance.

## Sky rise Lift issues (Levels 54-87)

At the moment only two lifts are operating in Sky Rise and this will continue for 3 months with parts having to come from overseas.

We understand lift wait times can be frustrating. Please consider this when you are denying lift access to a resident as the next lift could take a while to arrive.

#### **Goods lift Bookings**

Our loading dock team needs at least one weeks' notice for your move because its really busy at the moment.

Over the last few months there have been residents expecting to be bumped up when they have not booked their move, causing a lot of angst with those who have booked the lift as well as our staff.

The process is clear. Please contact the loading dock between 7am to 5pm Monday to Friday either on 9685 0116 or by email loadingdock@eurekatower.com.au to book your move.

**NOTE:** Delivery drivers who are not fully vaccinated will be turned away and your booking will be cancelled, so please make this clear to your removalist company.

# Pedestrians / Cyclists in the Car Park

Additional security to the car park triggers an alarm when a person walks or cycles within a certain permitter of the car park entry/exit.

To avoid constant alarms and assist in the overall security of the building, we ask pedestrians and bike riders to use/stay on the pedestrian walking area in front of the entry/exit doors, as well as the side pedestrian door.

In doing so, security can monitor unauthorised access to the building more successfully. Please help us to protect your belongings in the car park.
