EASING OF RESTRICTIONS

- The gym, pool and cinema are open as long as these areas are booked in advance, face masks are worn if and when you can, and social distance of 1.5m is practiced.
- The sauna is open with social distancing required.
- If you are required to self-isolate, please advise Concierge immediately and self-isolate. We will assist you anyway we can.
- All contractors and real estate agents to the site must have a COVID Safe Plan, do a temperature check and sign in. We require this information for contact tracing.
- Please advise our Loading Dock in advance if a contractor is coming to the site. Contractors should not be let up through the car park until they have registered their details with the loading dock first.
- Up to 15 people can visit you at home each day.

Goods Lift Bookings

Treat our staff with courtesy at all times. They are there to help and do their job. Its up to you to make the booking and ensure your delivery person has a **COVID Safe Plan.** Otherwise, they will NOT be permitted on site.
