Car Park Etiquette - Speeding

Speeding in the car park is not permitted at any time. There are many people walking through the car park to get to lifts and/or their vehicles. Elderly and



children who cannot always get out of the way quickly.

There have been a couple of near misses and one or two actual collisions in the car park recently. It happens. Please always be courteous, try to stay on the left side of the yellow line (difficult but please try) and drive slowly.

Contractor Sign In

Residents are reminded that all contractors doing internal apartment works

MUST sign in at the Loading Dock, prior to commencing any work, regardless what works they will be doing. Signing in ensures all works are authorised, induct-



ed, and alarms are isolated if necessary. This is also in compliance with the Owner's Corporation requirements. To make the process easier, instruct your contractors to enter via the Loading Dock at Cook St., where they can sign in first before being granted access to the foyer.

Parcel Deliveries

With the holiday season approaching, the amount of parcels getting delivered will also increase. We have seen this happen every year. Therefore, we ask residents to keep in mind the following:



- If you receive a delivery notification, wait for the My Parcel Locker SMS with your code (allow 15 minutes or so prior to collection as courier might still be in the mailroom depositing other parcels).
- If you did not receive an MPL code due to the lockers being full or the parcel being too big to fit the lockers, please wait until you get a mail slip in your mailbox in the afternoon.
- Allow extra time for sorting parcels that did not go into the lockers are processed manually. Your patience will be greatly appreciated.

Please note that Loading Dock and Concierge will not be able to assist with locating parcels until all deliveries are sorted and processed.

Keyset Barcodes and Secure Wire

Each resident's keyset that has been dropped off at the Concierge desk before is fitted with a barcode tag and secure wire for registration and tracking purposes.



Please do not remove, tamper with, or replace these tags.

Keysets without an attached barcode will require one if you wish to leave it at the desk. If a keyset has been registered with us before, but the barcode is removed, a \$25 replacement fee will apply to setup a new one.

Mail Box Keys

Car Park Security - Securing Your Vehicle

We've been notified of a few vehicle break-ins reported in nearby car parks in the area. Whilst Eureka Tower car park remains secure, we encourage all residents to stay cautious.



Ensure your car doors are locked, windows are fully closed, and no valuable items are left inside, or in view.

Goods Lift Bookings

With the busy holiday season approaching, we remind everyone to book the goods lift well in advance for any deliveries and moves, as times can be filled up quickly. Please aim to schedule your booking at least one to two weeks in advance.
